

Instructions for Using and Setting the TelaTip Indicator

This carton contains equal numbers of Tela*Tip* Tip Indicators, warning labels and bill of lading labels to be used as a system for encouraging proper handling by carriers and for monitoring your product for tip or tilt during transit. We suggest the bill of lading label be placed on the actual bill of lading to notify the carrier and consignee the shipment contains a warning device. The carton warning label should be placed on the package with the arrow up.

Activation and Mounting

The Tela*Tip* is activated by removing the metal activating tab located in the center. We suggest you use a small pair of pliers to remove the activation tab.

The Tela*Tip* has a pressure sensitive back to firmly attach it to your package. The release liner will lift off at the edge or corner.

The Tela*Tip* may be placed on the inside or the outside of the package with the arrow up.

Keep the Tela*Tip* upright while activating and mounting to prevent a premature readout of tipping.

Once the metal activating tab is pulled, the Tela*Tip* visually indicates the degree of tipping. Blue beads are displaced when a package is tipped recording the extent of tipping by turning the arrow-shaped recording window permanently and irreversibly from clear to blue.
